

## **Tips for Removing Permanent Adhesive Sticker Material**

Types of surfaces you may need to remove your permanent adhesive sticker material from:

- 1. Window/Glass
- 2. Plastic
- 3. Metal
- 4. Wood

<u>Important:</u> We do not recommended using a permanent adhesive sticker material on painted walls, as it could cause damage the wall upon removal.

## Common household solutions to help remove permanent sticker material and adhesives from surfaces:

- 1. Use some type of blade, card, or other removal tool to remove your sticker by gently pushing it along under the edge of the sticker. Be careful not to scratch the surface.
- 2. Hold a heat gun/hair dryer close to the sticker for about 30 seconds. With pressurized heat, the sticker will fall off/apart leaving no sticky residue.
- 3. Spray a penetrating oil such as WD-40® directly on the sticker and let it soak for close to an hour. The sticker should now come off with ease.
- 4. Soak a paper towel in rubbing alcohol or white vinegar and place the paper towel on the sticker for 30 minutes. The sticker should slide off easily.
- 5. After the sticker has been removed, use products designed to remove adhesive (such as, GooGone®, Orange Peel Citrus Cleaner, Rapid Remover®, etc)

<u>TIP:</u> Multiple removal practices may be done in unison to more effectively remove the sticker (e.g hair dryer and card or WD-40 and blade)
